- **Live access to the Competition webinars:** Applicants can watch all the presentations from fellow participants across all the webinars to learn from them.

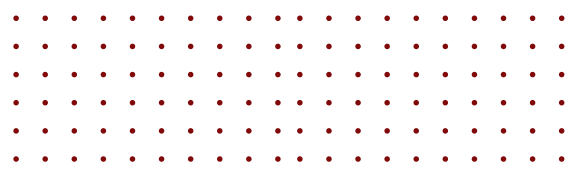

Environmental, Social, & Governance (ESG) Excellence Award



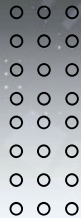
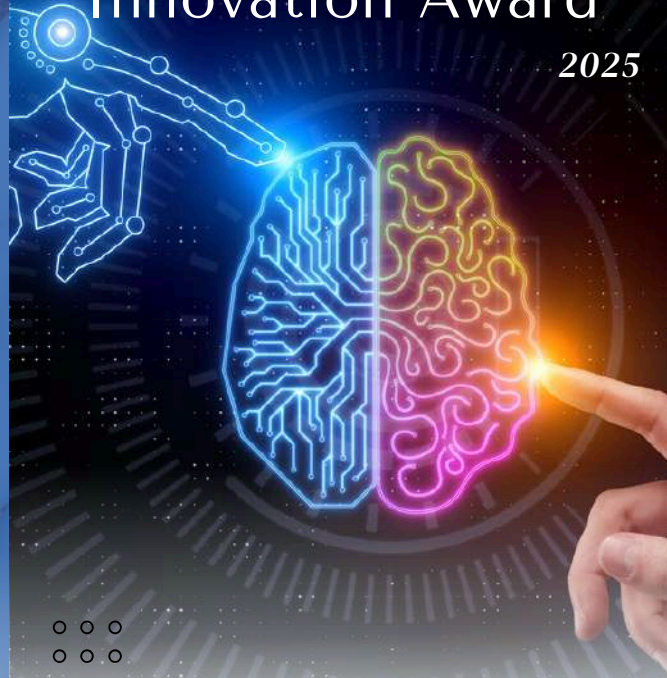
